



## THE ELEMENT EIGHT

### Eight guidelines to keep young people safe

We want Element to be a joyful place for young people to be on a Friday night. We also want them to be safe. Here are our eight guidelines to help protect young people and look after the King's Centre.

#### 1. HAVE A POSITIVE ATTITUDE

We expect all young people at Element to have a positive attitude.

#### 2. BE KIND

Threatening or intimidating language, violence, bullying, or putting others down is not acceptable.

#### 3. RESPECT THE SPEAKER

We give young people opportunities to lead from a young age. We expect all young people to respect our young preachers by being in the seating area, being quiet, and not distracting others.

#### 4. LOOK AFTER THE BUILDING

We expect young people not to deliberately damage our building or property, and to clean up any mess they make.

#### 5. NO FOOD IN THE AUDITORIUM

If young people bring food with them to Element, they'll be asked to eat it in the foyer, before entering the corridors and auditorium

#### 6. NO WEAPONS

No object that young people could use to harm themselves or others may be brought into element

#### 7. NO ALCOHOL OR DRUGS

Alcohol and substance taking are strictly forbidden and will be punished with immediate suspension from Element

#### 8. ONCE YOU'RE IN, YOU'RE IN

No young person may leave the king's centre between 7pm and 9pm without spoken parental permission.
