We want Disciple to be an opportunity for you to focus on your relationship with God, to learn more about God and the Bible, and to discover who he has made you to be. Our hope is that during the year, you go deeper with God, you develop existing and identify new gifts and skills, and you work to advance the Kingdom of God through the local church. We are probably even more excited about it than you are!

## ADVANCING THE KINGDOM

The internship will be made up of working in one or two ministry areas as well having other opportunities to be involved in a variety of activities and events happening at King's. You will work closely alongside the leaders of the chosen ministry areas. They will shape your time in those areas, giving you a taste of all that goes into the ministry and getting you fully involved in the work.

To help develop and stretch you, we will try our best to get you invovled a ministry area that you are passionate about and ministry areas that will be more of a challenge.

The internship can be full-time (5 days a week) or part-time (3.5 days a week), giving you the option to hold another part-time position as a source of income. You will need to be available to work Tuesdays and Sundays, as well as being able to attend ID training Zoom calls on Monday afternoons and three weeklong training blocks in Cambridge.

### **EXPLORING YOUR GIFTS**

Our hope is that you identify and develop new and existing gifts and skills throughout the year and so we will shape the year to give you opportunities to do just that. This will mainly be through different tasks and projects in your main ministry areas but there will be a variety of chances to try out new things and learn new skills.

We will, at times, push you out of your comfort zone but always in a safe and encouraging environment.

# **GROWING WITH OTHERS**

Alongside working at King's you will be part of ID, a year-long training programme, run by New Frontiers, for those doing a year out with their local church.

You will receive weekly Zoom calls and have three week-aways with your ID cohort throughout the year for teaching from great leaders in areas of theology, skills, leadership as well as discovering our identity in God. The ID training is a great opportunity to meet others in similar situations and learn together.

There will also be an opportunity to be involved in an overseas mission trip - and we will look out for conferences and other training opportunities that would be good for you and your area of work throughout the year.

# BEING PART OF THE STAFF FAMILY

More inhouse areas of growth include being a part of the weekly staff prayer meetings and monthly staff training, as well as any other opportunity of courses and training run by our leaders. Once a month you will have a Day of Reflection – a day to spend focused on God, whether that be studying the Bible, worshipping and praying or reading a book, or a creative mixture of it all

Each day at King's you will have an hour to pray, worship, read or study as you see fit. We will also give you a list of recommended books to read podcasts to listen to and videos to watch.

## **COSTS & PRACTICALITIES**

The Internship is unpaid but also free! We will cover all costs associated with the ID training course, including travel expenses to and from the training, as well as any other training that you go on as part of the internship. We will also contribute to the cost of your overseas mission trip.

All living and personal costs during the year are to be covered by you.
