Job Description

- ◆ To serve, honour and worship God.
- ◆ To lead the church in worship on Sundays and at other meetings.
- ◆ To support worship for other church events as the need arises.

Duties

- ◆ To prepare in advance for the worship 'set', as provided by the Worship Leader.
- ◆ Arrive at church in good time to set up, sound check and prepare for services, meetings and rehearsals.
- ◆ Clear away and tidy up Worship Team area after services, meetings and rehearsals.
- ◆ Work with the PA team to accomplish a good sound balance.
- ◆ Lead the church primarily in sung praise, thanksgiving and worship.
- ◆ Work together at preparing new songs for use in church.
- ◆ Individually and corporately endeavour to deepen our worship of God, for the benefit of the church.

Qualifications

- ◆ **Church membership is a requirement for being on a worship team serving at church meetings and events (unless one is a Uni student and already a member of their home church).**
- ◆ A basic level of skill in your chosen instrument (informal assessment will be required).
- ◆ To worship authentically; whether on stage or in the congregation.
- ◆ To have a heart both to worship and to lead people in worship.
- ◆ To be lead worshippers - an encouragement to others in the congregation.

Commitment

- ◆ Regular attendance at weekly band rehearsals (midweek evening, day varies from band to band).
- ◆ Mandatory attendance for rehearsals during the week leading up to a Sunday morning serving.
- ◆ **Current commitment for Sunday mornings is 2 Sundays in a row, followed by 2 Sundays off.** Serving at other meetings/ events varies depending on availability, etc.
- ◆ Personal times of rehearsal and building of skill in your chosen instrument.
